## **Celebrate Presidents' Day at the Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson**

The Augusta home where President Woodrow Wilson spent his formative years during the Civil War and Reconstruction will be open for FREE tours on Monday, February 15<sup>th</sup> in honor of Presidents' Day. Tours will be given every half hour between 10 am and 4 pm. The last tour will begin at 4 pm. Everyone is encouraged to visit this National Historic Landmark.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson is located at 419 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta. In addition to Presidents' Day, The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson is open for tours during regularly scheduled times Tuesday through Saturday, with tours offered on the hour from 10 am through 4 pm. Group tours are offered by appointment. Regular admission is \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors, \$3 for students K-12 and free for children under 5.
